Statement Regarding Positive Conflict Writ Notice to AG Bonta

(Fresno, Ca) - As a governor elect of California I have already begun to hold our elected officials accountable. [Today I mailed a letter to Attorney General Rob Bonta](#) informing him of my intent to nullify Prop 64 on my first day in office (<https://rb.gy/lyl70z>). The positive conflict between state and federal laws regarding cannabis cultivation is more than obvious which is why I have sent a letter of notification to the AG explaining what actions I plan to take once elected. The people of California are demanding that the new governor makes swift moves in undoing all the mistakes Gavin Newsom has made. Being one of those residents of the state myself that shares that same sentiment, there will be no delay in me making broad changes quickly as Governor.

Destruction of property and peoples livelihoods under Prop 64 have caused even more ruin to the decaying political and economical climate harming everyone in California. Lockdowns due to Gavin Newsom's response over Covid19 have already had a severe impact on our state leading to incalculable losses of jobs, businesses and the revenue they produce. Jump-starting our economy immediately will be a focal point with me as Governor and I will be looking to any and all state officials to aid me in that effort.

Over policing and regulation has stagnated our state's marijuana industry which in the past had been an equal opportunity for anyone seeking it. Money was being made hand over foot which unfortunately created a greedy government that expected to be paid a portion of profits made or suffer harsh penalties for refusing to pay to play. Prop 64 codified this criminal activity making individuals and those state officials involved liable under federal law.

People in California overwhelmingly support each person's natural right to consume marijuana which is why Prop 64 passed by a majority, however they were misled to believe that the criminal elements involved would no longer apply which is not the case. Once I am elected Governor on September 14th 2021, this misnomer will be speedily addressed and remedied so Californians can grow cannabis and make cannabis purchases confidently without having to worry that they are breaking the law.
